The Henderson County State's Attorney's Office serves the citizens of Henderson County, Illinois, which number approximately 6,300. The City of Oquawka is the county seat and houses the second oldest functioning courthouse in the State of Illinois. The state's attorney's office is comprised of the state's attorney, a victim-witness coordinator, and an administrative assistant. The office has a wide range of duties and responsibilities which include: prosecuting felony, misdemeanor, and traffic cases; prosecuting juvenile cases; providing victim-witness services; providing legal guidance to the county board and elected and appointed county officials.

The salary is currently set at approximately \$160,000.00.
